Our Mission and Philosophy:

We are on a mission to have couples across America shut off the TV and share a glass of wine with each other nightly. We believe that by achieving our mission we will cut the divorce rate in half.

Our philosophy is to produce premium class Washington and Oregon wines, with exotic brands and provocative back labels that are just a bit risqué. We aim to please the palate, change the conversation and enhance the romantic encounter around wine.

At Naked Winery the entire experience surrounding wine should be fun. Read our back labels or better yet have your mother-in-law read the back label aloud at your next family function and laugh out loud. As we say, drink what you like and who wouldn't like to get Naked now and then?

About Our Winery and Wines:

Naked Winery is family owned (Barringer & Michalec) and headquartered in our home town of Hood River, Oregon. We operate federally bonded wineries in both Oregon and Washington. Here in Hood River, in addition to our tasting room we operate a production winery on Industrial Loop, at the corner of 13th and Wasco. (see photo inset)

Our current varietals are: Barbera, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Gewurztraminer, Merlot, Muscat, Nebbiolo, Pinot Blanc, Pinot Gris, Pinot Noir, Riesling, Sangiovese, Symphony, Syrah, Tempranillo, Viognier and Zinfandel.

We source much of our fruit from vineyards in Willamette and Rogue Valleys which benefit from the cool pacific marine layers at night and sunshine during the day. We then employ predominantly French oak barrels and the resultant wine has a fruit forward bouquet followed by structured, subtle and complex notes on the palate.

The fruit for our Washington wine originates in the Columbia Valley, Wahluke Slope, Horse Heaven Hills and Columbia Gorge AVAs. Here in the Gorge we are proud to use local fruit from names you might know: Czarnecki Family, Gunkel Family and Waving Tree Vineyards. The delicate varietals that make up our Columbia Gorge fruit are aged on mostly neutral French/American oak, have a lower alcohol level and are perfectly balanced for food. Whereas, the varietals in the Eastern Washington area are exposed to higher heat and these vines struggle with just enough drip irrigated water to produce exceptionally bold fruit. The wines produced from these berries are "Big", powerful and earthy with higher alcohol levels that



offer sweetness and a round mouth feel. Aged in primarily in new American Oak they deliver a fantastic experience on the nose, followed by earthy flavors and a long finish.
